THE MEANING OF MONROEISM

One of the most lucid and satisfactory of the many definitions of the Monroe doctrine, says the Globe-Democrat, is that furnished by Prof. McMaster, the well-known American historian. He draws an analogy between this doctrine and other declarations which our country had previously made, such as that government derives its power from the consent of the governed, etc. These declarations were once denied and condemned, but they are now accepted, and the Monroe doctrine rightly stands with them. The immediate impetus of President Monroe's declaration was England's opposition of the Holy alliance, but it was not intended simply for that occasion. It was the expression of a general and continuous policy with regard to European interference in the affairs of the new world. The doctrine of non-intervention, which declared that no government in Europe should be allowed in any way to control the destinies of the republics on this side of the Atlantic, was perfectly plain and rested upon the same basis as the Declaration of Independence, to-wit: the necessity of defending republicanism on this continent against the attacks and machinations of European nations. That was what it meant then, and that is what it means now. It has not forfeited its vitality or its applicability with the lapse of years, but is still a living and very important part of our policy of self protection.

ably by the public land committee. The bill, which is an important one to the people of this section, provides for the refunding to the settlers within forfeited railroad grants of all more than \$1.25 per acre, paid by those who settled on even numbered sections, and who paid the double minimum price. The fact that the railroads were not built as anticipated, made these lands no more valuable than other sections and the proposed refunding would be a simple act of justice to those settlers who paid the double price, thinking that the expected construction of the roads would justify it. The bill, it is thought, will elicit opposition in the senate, but its passage is no less deserved.
