ropean interterence in the affairs of the new world．The doctrine of non－inter－ vention，which declared that no govern－
ment in Europe ehould be allowed in ment in Europe ehould be allowed in
any way to control the deatinies of the republics on this side of the Allantic，
was perfectly plain and rested upon the same basis as the Declaration of Inde－
pendence，to－wit：the n－cessity of de－ fending republicanism on this continent against the attacks and machinations of
European nations．That was what it meant then，and that is what it means
now． now．It has not forfeited its vitality or
its applicability with the lapse of years， but is still a living and very important part of our policy of self protection．
As for England＇s contention that terri－ tory once settled by her subjects belongs to her，even if the boundary line be dis－
putable，Prof．McMaster declarea it to be putable，Prof．MeMaster declares it to be she has not herself insisted apon if in previous and similar instances．$\cdot$ He
