That night the Three Friends circled around at sea. On Friday, May 29, she again cautiously approached the Cuban coast about nightfall, west of Trinidad, and a rocket-the signal agreed uponwas sent up. It was answered from shore. There were six surfboats on board, and in these the men and arms were transferred to shore. In four hours the landing was completed, and the Three Friends stood for the Florida const.

This is the third expedition the Three Friends has landed in Cuba. Captain Broward would give no information about the Laurada, save that when she left Jacksonville she had men and arms or Cuba, and that he expected to soon hear of her being in some Jamaican port.




