Lillian Ashley turned pale and almost fainted in the witness chair. Attorney James Crittenton, for the defense, rushed to the assistance of Emma Ashlev, putting his hand in his pistol pocket. Unruh covered Crittenton with Emma's pistol, but Crittenton drew his pistol and the spectators thought more shooting would follow. Attorneys Lloyd and Highton and the court officials came between the excited men, and the clerk of the court took the revolvers from them. Meantime Emma Ashley had run across followed by Baldwin, who thought she had another pistol. Baldwin, win held Emma until the bailiff escorted her to the city prison, where she was booked on a charge of assault to commit murder.

Emma Ashley is believed to be insane, During the trial she has spent her time in court reading the Bible. When taken to jail she sang "Nearer My God to Thee'' in a loud voice.

Baldwin was crazy with rage and wanted a chance to fight some one. His hair was singed by the powder and the bullet passed within an inch of his head. 
