Counting the four states first mentioned as certain to be represented by Republican senators in the rext congress, and letting the vacancies in Kentucky and Delaware balance each other, the new senate would stand: Repulicans 47, combined opposition 43. That is a conservative view. Should Kansas, Missouri and South Dakota also elect Republican senators, as seems possible, the result would be: Republicans 50, combined opposition 40. This computation takes no account of the silver senators whose successors are to be elected, they being classed with the opposition. One loss may be sustained in Utah, which state Arthur Brown now represents. Senator Brown refused to bolt the St. Louis convention, but his term does not expire until March 4, 1898. So a tariff bill can be passed before his successor, who may be a free silver adherent, can be elected. All of which goes to show that the Republicans are assured practically of four majority against the combined opposition in the next senate, and possibly a majority of ten.
