A Dozen Strikers at Bay Empty their Revolvers at the Soldiers, who Reply With Rifle Balls.

CLEVELAND, Aug. 6 .- Between midnight and 1 o'clock this morning a crowd made an attack on a building where a man named Johnson, employed at Brown's hoisting works, lives. They broke the windows and yelled like Indians. Soldiers rushed to the scene. Part of the crowd scattered, but a dozen men stood at bay with revolvers and fired at the militiamen. The soldiers replied with rifle balls. Then the men scattered. In the melee Private Perkins, of Company B, was shot, but it is not known how seriously. More serious trouble is anticipated.
