during this decade, and her manufacturers have had every possible opthe markets of the world, yet we find that the total British exports of irou and machinery combined decreaser by over $\$ 80,000,000$ a year between 1884 and 1894.
It weuld almost seem as if the ab-
ence of a wall of protection had worked entirely contzary to all fre trade theories in England's case, be ufacturers and producers of iron steel, tin plate, wire, hardware, coal
and machinery to sell in the English markets nearly $\$ 100,000,000$ worth more of their products and mann factures in 1894 than they did 1884 Free trade in Eugland has increased
the imports of the above mentioned goods by nearly $\$ 20,000,000$ sterling and has decreased the exports. by more than $\$ 16,000,000$ sterling. The figures quoted are from the officia board of trade returns.
Taking the quautities of the Eng. lish exports, we find that the Unite Kingdom has sold under its poliey of Iree trade 840,000 tons leass of iro 1884. Her exports of pig iron de creased by nearly 440,000 tons; nearly 170,000 tons. of rilrond in by 305,000 tons, and of hoops,

that we are undoubtedly buying less of these commodities from our Eng lish neighbors and have helped ma-
terially to dimimsh their manefact ures and their output. Perhaps thi
is the real reason why they wish is the real reason why they wish
