

The advocate of free coinage insists that the demand to be created by a free coipage law will enhance the price of silver and bring it to or near a parity with gold. If this be so how will laborers and farmers be able to get it any easier than they can now get gold? But the experience of France disproves this contention. Prior to 1853 France was on a silver basis, gold having gone out of circulation because of a premium of about 14 per cent; in 1853 a demand for silver for export from Europe to India raised the commercial value of silver to a premium and France began the coinage of gold. For five years she coined 80 per cent of the world's product and yet gold during that time depreciated one per cent. In 1859 she coined \$130,000,000, which was \$10,000,000 in excess of the entire product of the world for that year, and yet the price continued to fall and at the close of that year was 2 per cent below par of silver.
