then made a detour to the eonthward and euddenly appeured at Artemisa, the ceniral post on the line of the trocha.

gurgent chief sent word to the commandant that he intended to bombard the town, giving the inhabitante five
hours in which to ieave the eity. Not heeding Maceo's threats, the spaniard would permit no one to leave. The re
sult is known from the reports which save airendy been cabled from Havana. Maceo opened fire on the town with his artillery and thirty shots from the
rebel dynamite kuns were thrown into the city. Every building io said to have been leveled while the elanghter of non carnage Maceo and bis followers crosed
the line of the trocha into Havann the line of the trocha into Havan
provinee, where they will be joined by the forces of General Agairre.
