The Dalles is glad to see you, and all of you, and extends to you, and each of you, the freedom of the city. We have not much, but such as we have is yours, and if you don't see what you want, ask for it. We appreciate your rejoicing with us in the beginning of the new era of our prosperity, and the prosperity of Eastern Oregon.

We will be brought into closer contact with the balance of the state, and into nearer and larger business relations with our neighbors down the river.
