WASHINGTON, Nov. 14 .- In view of the recent statements of some of the silver senators that they would not oppose the Dingley tarlff bill, and the opinion of Senator Morgan that the Democrats would probably permit the legislation without obstruction on their part, the prospects for the bill are deemed fair, if the Republicans decide to pass it. Upon the latter contingency there is a division of opinion among Republicans. Senator Sherman, of Ohio, takes the ground that the passage of the Dingley bill at the coming session would obviate the necessity for an extra session of congress, as it would furnish the revenue needed for the present and would be sufficient for all purposes until congress shall meet in regular session and prepare a revision Discovery is all that is claimed for it; it of the tariff carefully and deliberately.
