The senator says that he has no idea that there will be any attempt to pass the Dingley bill at this session of congress, it is a piece of legislation that failed at the last session and ought to fail at any session. When asked about the policy of the silver senators in the next congress, he said:

"They will hold the balance of power in the senate and will, no doubt, conmaking all other issues subordinate to that. There can be no prosperity under the McKinley administration, any more than there was under Cleveland. Mc-Kinley wants a high tariff and a gold standard. No matter what kind of a tariff we have, there can be no prosperity except for a few, under the gold standard. One more trial of the Republican party will convince the people of this, in my judgment, and the silver advocates will win the congress in '98 and the presidency in 1900."
