ORDINANCE NO. 182. The following is a part of ordinance No. 182, to provide for the taxing and killing of dogs: The owners or persons having in charge any dog permitted to run at large within the city limits, shall, on or before the 12th day of May of each year, pay into the city treasury the sum of \$1.50 for each and every male dog, and the sum of \$3 for each and every slut or female dog, which shall entitle him to a receipt from the treasurer, which receipt shall be numbered and shall designate the sex of the dog and the owner's name and the amount paid; and upon the presentation of each receipt to the recorder, he shall issue a license to the holder thereof, which shall designate the owner's name and the number of the license, which number shall correspond with that worn by the dog or slut.
