$\begin{gathered}\text { An Americon Bark } 133 \\ \text { Duty in Engilinh waters. }\end{gathered}$ The bark True Love, buiit in Phila-
delphia in 1764, has been found upon search to be yet afloat in the capacity of
a coal hulk, engaged in active trade at the age of 133 years. This discovery was Martime Exchange as follows: "True Love," barge, was in collision with schooner Gravesend of London o

aged to such an extent that it was foumd aged to such an extent that it was foun

not only outlived her builders and their successors, but has also outlived every craft that was built in her time and for many years afterward, and this fact,
