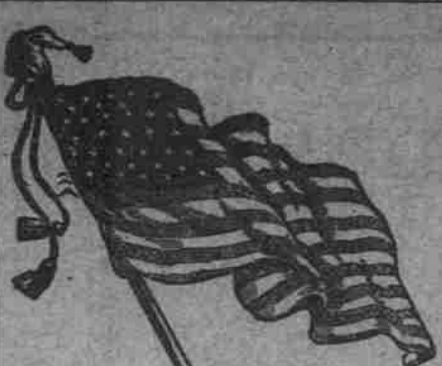
Light Works Burned.
