POLICY OF ENGLAND

British Rights in China will be Upheld.

RUSSIAN RIGHTS NOT RECOGNIZED

If the Czar's Warships Winter at Port Arthur, British Vessels Must Have the Same Right.

MANCHESTER, Jan. 3 .- The Manchester Guardian says :

"The government has categorically stated that Great Britain will refuse to recognize any special rights granted at any Chinese ports to any particular power. Any port opened to any one power must be open to all or open to none. If Russia has been granted the right to winter ships at Port Arthur, Great Britain will enforce her rights to the same privilege, and her ships will does not concede them the right to do Cough Remedy.

"'If Germany obtains naval stations at Kaio Chou, Great Britain insists on cure. having a lease of ground for a naval station at the same port, and she will support every other power in the same claim. The contention of the government is that the most favored nation clause in British and all other treaties with China forbids any special concessions of the nature contemplated by Germany at Kaio Chou, and prevents the nation from acquiring special benefits in which other nations do not have

"The government has also declared that the same principle applies to such transactions as railway and mine monopolies. Taking her stand on the treaties, Great Britain refuses to recognize such concessions and will insist upon similar railway and mine rights and will use such force to secure or defend them as is necessary. This declaration does not apply to concessions of territory to which existing treaties do not refer, but relative to this contingency, the dispatch sent by the government to China says that when it occurs, a graver question will arise.

"It is reported a similar declaration has been delivered to the Chinese and other governments by Japan."
