The following remarkable calculation on the length of time which it would take a person to count 1, 600,000,000 reently appeared in an issue of an Engsh periodical: What is a billion? he reply is very simple. In England a illion is a million times a million. 1,000,000,000,000). This is quickly written and quicker still pro-nounced. But no man is able to count it. You will count 160 or 170 a minute. But let us suppose that you go up as high as 200 a minute, hour after hour. At that rate you would count 12,000 an hour; 288,000 a day, or 105,-20,000 in a year. Let us suppose now that Adam, at the beginning of his existence, had begun to count, and had continued to do so and was counting still. Had such a thing been possible, he would not yet have finished the task of counting a billion! To count a billion would require a person to count too a minute for a period of 9,512 years, 542 days, 5 hours and 20 minutes, providing he should count continuously. But uppose we allow the counter 12 hours daily for rest, eating and sleeping. Then he would need 18,025 years, 319 days, 10 hours and 45 minutes in which to comlete the task!






