Peace hetween Spain and th United States is made probable by
the strength of our North Atlantcic the strength of our North Atlantte
tquadron. Admiral Sieard has at his disposal for use in West Indian waters a fleet of which any nava
commander in the world mould be proud. In it are the first-class line of battleships Indiana, Iowa and Massachusetts; the second elass battleships Maine, Texas, Brooklyn and New York; two double terreled monitors, which, though classed as coast defenders, can fight effectively in any waters, naval vessels of therr own tonnage; and several cruisers and four or five torped o.boats. I is comfortung to know that we are so well insured aganst Spain. Against stronger nations we need more am ple protection.
The secretary of the navv, says the Inter Ocean, wisely recommends the purchase of armor plate for the comWisconsin, which will launching soon atter the plate is suppliedi. The secretary's recommendation is without prejudice to the erec tion of a government armor-plate plant, which he believes can be had by an expenditure of from 83,500, ,
$\mathbf{0 0 0}$ to $84,500,000$, hut in consideration of the evident impossibility of having such a plant ready for work in less than eighteen months, he urges the speedy completion of the ships now under way.
At present our navy is fifth in importance in sea power, or rather our navy and that of Germany have equal claim to fifth rank. Great
Britain, France, Russia and Italy Britain, France, Russia and 1taly
stand first, second, third and fourth in number of warships and force of guns.
We have four first-class battleships in course of construction, not conntwhich practically are compieted shough they are not yet formally accepted by the government. We achave sixteen other vessels, armor have sisteen other vesses, armored cruisers, monitors, gunboats, and torpedo boats under construction When these are attoat we shall surpass Germany, unless, indeed, the emperir prevail upon the reichstag to make appropriations for the larg additions that he desires for the Ger man navy.
Yet the strength of a naval force is not soley dependent upcn the
number of ships afloat. Quality of construction, calibre of guns, ability of officers and seamen, and facilities for coaling and repairing count for much. With all these conditions, except the last named, we have reason to be satisfied. Our ships are the best of their class, their armamente are perfect, and the quality or our sailors has been tested time and again. But we are without a coaling place or harbor of, refuge in what may be called the Central Pacafic. Samoa would be of immense value in a conflict wherein the Australian or New Zealand trade or possessions of Great Britain were irvolved, but we have no "corgne of vantage" the seute of the great Asiatic trade or in the wide reach of waters where in the battle for possession of the west coast of this continent would be decided. Hawaii offers us the one thing lacking.
