MANY SLAVES TO COCAINE.

Life-Destroying Drug Being More Extensively Used Every Day.

According to a British medical authority there can be no doubt that in many parts of the world cocaine inebriety is largely on the increase. Many writers speak of it as the third scourge of humanity, alcohol and morphine being the first and second. The greatest number of victims is to be found among society women and among women who have adopted literature as a profession. A considerable proportion of chronic cocaineists have fallen under the dominion of the drug from a desire to stimulate their powers of imagination. Others have acquired that habit quite innocently from taking cocaine wines fortified with salts of the alkaloid in solution. One drug habit rapidly engenders another, and the victim of chronic cocaineism is usually addicted to overindulgence in alcohol, besides being a confirmed cigarette smoker. Stringent measures should be taken to stamp out an evil which, if once established, is difficult to eradicate. Cocaine wines made from cocaine, and cocaine lozenges and tablets should be supplied with the utmost caution. Cocaine and other medicated wines are largely sold to people who are considered abstainers. Originally cocaine wine was made from coca leaves, but it is now commonly a solution of the alkaloid in a sweet and usually strong alcoholic wine. Not long ago a physician reported the case of a man who, thinking to abjure the use of alcoholic stimulants, drank coca wine so freely that he died of delirium tremens.

### DANGERS OF OPHTHALMY.

Removal of the Crystalline Lens Requires Great Care.

While many physicians regard the operation of removing the crystalline lens dangerous, because of possibility of retinal hemorrhage and perhaps diminution of tension, there are others who endorse the views of Prof. Herman Cohn, chief of staff of the Ophthalmic hospital, Breslau, and Prof. Vincenz Fukala, of the University of Vienna, that removal of the crystalline lens is a cure for myopia, or near-sightedness, and unaccompanied by danger to the patient. For centuries this operation has been resorted to as a cure for cataract and now cocaine and antiseptic surgery render it comparatively safe. Myopia is caused by a diffusion of light, and where diffusion is greatest vision is most impaired. In light the pupil of the eye contracts and expands again in darkness. When the pupil is enlarged the diffusion of light is enlarged. With age the pupil becomes smaller, hence the vision of near-sighted people improves as they grow older.

It is claimed that when the crystalline lens is removed the cornea will concentrate the rays of light. Prof. Fukala first dared to step from theory to practice and perform the operation. After administering cocaine the lens was punctured to produce cataract, or the hardened condition which renders it easy of removal. Cases reported by Prof. Fukala show that after the operation patients have been able to see at a distance of from 35 to 60 centimeters.

### Deceiving the Goat.

A flagman of a German railway was recently told that he would be fined if his wife was again seen flagging a train. The man said she had never done so, and explained as follows: Being ill, she asked her husband to milk the goat. This animal was, however, unused to anyone but the woman herself, and the flagman, to save trouble, dressed in his wife's clothes to deceive the goat. A shrill whistle reminded him of his duties, and he saluted the passing express in skirts.
