**HISTORY REPEATED.**

**SIDEBORD SCARFS.**

Suitable Covers for Smooth Articles of Furniture.  
A dainty scarf for the sideboard may be made of a piece of linen lawn measuring one and three-quarters, or two yards, in length, by fifteen to eighteen inches in width. Hemstitch the edge one inch and a half in depth, and an inch from the hemstitching embroider a design of sweet peas in the natural size and with the natural colors of pink and white Asiatic flax.

Work the flowers in long and short stitch and the stems and tendrils in stem stitch with gray-green Asiatic flax. This scarf will be found very satisfactory placed upon a highly polished surface, but is not a suitable cover for a coarse piece of furniture. The same size and kind of scarf will be very satisfactory worked with a design of carnations etched with black Asiatic flax. Represent the blossoms in groups of two and three in a place with crossed stems or as if dropped on.

A heavier linen scarf may be embroidered with yellow chrysanthemums, or even with "black-eyed-Susans." Work the petals with Roman floss in satin stitch and the center with dark brown or black Asiatic rope silk in French knot stitch.—Womankind.
