FIRESIDE FRAGMENTS.

—Cocoa Balls.—Before the fondant is very stiff, take out about a cupful. Knead into it as much grated cocoanut as possible, form into balls, brush with white of egg and roll in dry cocoanut.

—Polish for Floors.—Boil together one cup of strong beer, a piece of beeswax about the size of a nut, and a spoonful of sugar. First clean the floor by wiping it over with warm beer, and then apply the polish with a brush.

—Beef and Carrots.—Chop one pound of beef (not too fine). Cook slowly with three sliced carrots in water, enough to cover until well done. Season with salt, pepper, tablespoonful of butter, one-half teaspoonful of onion juice.

—Plain Custard.—The beaten yolks of five eggs and five teaspoonfuls of sugar. Pour over this one quart of hot milk, add flavoring and the whites of two eggs. Bake in cups set in a pan of boiling water.

—Cocoanut Creams.—These are made by dropping some grated cocoanut and a few drops of vanilla in some of the fondant; work like dough, roll out, cut in cubes and allow to harden.

—Apple Butter.—Boil three gallons of cider down to one-fourth of the quantity. Pare and core as many apples as the cider will cover. Divide the cider and put equal parts in two kettles on the fire.
