Strong Evidence that an Enemy Caused the Explosion-The Story Lacks Confirmation.

A wounded sailor in the marine hospital at Key West has told a New York Herald correspondent that while looking over the Maine's bow into Havana destruction, he saw an illuminated missile-apparently a torpedo-approaching in the waters, and that before he could give the alarm the explosion occurred.

"I learn on undoubted authority that one of the Maine's sailors who was taken to the marine hospital, out of gratitude for the kind treatment and careful nursing received from surgeons and attendand which points to the deliberate destruction of the vessel.

"The sailor, whose name for obvious easons is withheld for the present, says While looking over the Maine's bow into the waters of the bay he saw a black bject slowly approaching the vessel. The object, whatever it was, was apparently illuminated and emitted smoke. He suspected something wrong and started to communicate the fact to the officer of the day, when the explosion occurred. 
