OBSERVATIONS BY PROCTOR.

The statement made by Senator Proctor in the senate Thursday materrally increased the prospect of in tervention by this country in the Cuban war. Senator Proctor went to Cuba as a dispassionate observer and returns to this country horrified at the warfare Spain has carried on. It was a striking scene in the senate when Proctor arose and made known the results of his personal observations, and the attention paid to his remarks shows how deep is the interest taken in this question. The horrible condition existing in Cuba can be realized from these words of Proctor:

"Outside of Havana all is changed. It is not peace, nor is it war: it is desolation and destruction, misery village is surrounded by a trocha, a sort of rifle pit, but constructed on a plan new to me, dirt being thrown up on the outside and the barbed-wire fence on the other side of the trench. I saw no house or hut in the 400 miles of railroad rides from Pinar del Rio province in the west, cross the full width of Havana and Matanzas provinces and to Sagua la Grande, on the north shore, and to Cienfuegos, on the south shore of Santa Clara, except within the Spanish trochas. 
