RAG RUGS.

Make Them.

Quite satisfactory rugs may be knit prices to suit the times. Also mill feed. or sewn together from rags, but the most durable rag rugs are those woven with warp. Old ingrain carpets, woolen goods of any kind or description may cellent rag carpets are also made out are more durable than those made of wool, and they are lighter. The dust ean be shaken out of them more readily, and if necessary they can be put into a washtub and thoroughly cleaned. They are, therefore, more useful than woolen rag earpets in the kitchen. Cheese Eggs. To make cheese eggs boil an egg till herd and remove the shell. Carefully out off one end with a sharp kuife. scoop out the yolk; chop it fine and mix it with a little pepper, sait, grated cheese and vinegar. Stuff the whites with this paste. For forced eggs boil an egg ten minutes and carefully remove the shell. Cut in half, remove the yolk, mix it well with an equal quantity of butter and anchovy paste, and add a touch of cayenne pepper. Fill the egg with the well-mixed paste and put the two halves together .- Pittsburgh Dispatch.




