RATES FOR THE ENCAMPMENT.

Lines on Which Rates Have Been Reduced on Kannd-trip Tickets.

Rates to the encampment over the Southern Pacific road and its branches will be one and one-third fare for the round trip. Each purchaser will pay full fare for a ticket one way and take a These receipts will contain a certificate sion & Grocery Co.'s. to be signed by the assistent adjutantgeneral, and will entitle the holder to return for one-third fare. The parties failing to secure these receipts at the time of purchasing tickets will loose the benefit of the reduced rates. These certificates must be presented at Portland 134 Third street, and grand central station for the main line on East Side and Woodburn Springfield branches, also West Side division main line. Rates over the Oregon Railroad and and one-fifth fare for round trip on all ticke. their lines, except from Portland to The Dalles, where a special rate of \$3 for the round trip has been made, and, as in the case of the Southern Pacific, the purchaser of a ticket will pay full fare one way and get a receipt and certificate, which, when signed by the assistant adjutant general, will entitle the holder to return for one fitth fare.
