Untaught by the lessons of recent history, they are seeking aid in the European capitals to save our country from ruin, as if it were possible for Spain to obtain in her distress that which was refused her before she had suffered a single defeat.

Consequently European sympathy Yalu, however, caused a complete Snipes Kinersly Drug Co. revulsion of official feeling. From the day the news of the Japanese victory reached European capitals China had no friends. She was regarded as a helpless body, to be drawn in the financial interest of Europe and to be quartered by the sword of conquest.

The experience of Greece was even as that of China. At the outbreak of the Turko-Grecian war public men in Europe calculated almost to a certainty upon the defeat of the bankrupt and demoralized Turkey. The heroic days of classic Greece and the glamour of the Greek rebellion sufficed to blind even the Elegent shrewdest statesmen of Europe to the future. Greece was expected to Tourist win, and all the world loved her. But no sooner had the Athens government lost the preliminary battles of the campaign than gentlemen representing the Deutsche bank in Berlin gathered with cold, unlovely calculation to pick the bones in behalf of the bondholders in the concert of Europe.

The Sparish statesmen who are appealing to the rest of Europe in their Through Tickets present extremity would do well to remember these two modern instances, and to take to heart the lesson that philanthropy and charity have no place in the international intercourse of Europe. 


