FORTITUDE OF THE SAILORS.

The danger of exposing unacclimated troops to the diseases which ravage Cuba in the rainy season is doubtless one of the considerations which have led the government to delay the invasion of the island. The forward movement now believed to be at hand, if not under way, may have been dictated solely by military necessity, but it is permitted to hope that the government feels justified in believing that rigid regulations respecting food, clothing and all sanitary possibilities will greatly diminish the risk to be incurred. It is conceivable also that the authorities have taken into serious account the fact that the blockading forces cannot endure for an indefinite time the conditions which have surrounded them for more than a month, and which are constantly growing more oppressive.

Our sailors, who entered upon their work with splendid spirit, have performed it with perfect devotion, and are unquestionably anxious on doing their duty, whatever it may be, in the same manner. Their zeal is beyond suspicion, but their efficiency may not be proof against impairment. The suspense which they are enduring is in itself no slight strain, and would be, even if their circumstances were otherwise wholly favorable.

But a more important consideration is that they have been subjected all these weeks to the blistering heat of steel ships under a tropical sun, and it is too much to expect that they can retain their full strength and vigor for months to come in such a situation. If necessary they will endure the ordeal as best they can, but if without undue risk the war can be shortened by an immediate combination of military and naval operations the present suffering of our seamen is one of the valid arguments in favor of a joint campaign.

Whatever may be determined upon by those who have the knowledge and the responsibility, it seems no more than fitting to remind the country with what fortitude the men aboard the fleets in Cuban waters have done their depressing and debilitating work. Not a word of fault-finding has come from them, and we have no idea that a single complaint will be heard, however long their tedious patrol may last. But all the more for this reason is it incumbent on their fellow-citizens to recognize and applaud their devotion and to rejoice in their prospect of being called to more inspiring, though not more honorable, tasks.
