Commodore Watson would be in command of the finest squadron affoat that has been in actual naval war. Among his vessels would be battleships that have made the longest voyages at a high rate of speed on record. These same vessels have also made the best fighting records of any of the modern battleships.

The presence of such a fleet in European waters would be like waying in the face of the naval powers the championship flog in ship-building, in gunnery, and in seaworthiness. Wherever it went the people would be curious to see the type of war vessels that accomplished so much with so little injury to themselves. Without any feeling of unfriendliness to this country the great naval powers of Europe may not care to have such an exhibition of American proficiency in European waters. It proves too much. It is a living illustration of the power of a republic to do as well or better in ship-building than any monarchy. It is a practical illustration of the growing power and influence of the United States.
