The French Embassy Asks for the Release of the French Prize, the Olinde Rodriguz.

Washington, July 28 .- The French embassy has called the attention of the state department to the circumstances circulars and testmonials. Address, connected with the seizure of the French merchant steamship Olinde Rodriguez, and has requested the immediate release of that steamer. The action was taken simultaneously with a protest from the French Transatlantic Steamwhile Company against the seizure. The state department has submitted all the papers in the case to the department of justice, with a view to getting an opinion on the legal questions involved.
