'All visitors to Camp Bon-Homme are bereby notified that bon bons are highly acceptable and under no circumstances will they be refused.



For this reason a warrant has been attached to each delinquent roll commanding the sheriff to collect all taxes by serzure and sale of to cure or price refunded. For sale at property. 
