DEATH RATE IN ARMIES.

The death rate in the United States army, regulars and volunteers, for the four months of service, is 5.4 in a thousand. This is on a basis of 240,-000 men in the field, representing an annual death rate of 16,2. Averaging the length of service at three months, so as to include the second enlistments in June, the death rate per month is 1.8 per thousand, or an annual death rate of 21.6 per thousand from disease. In the general reports on vital statistics published by the government the annual death rate in Chicago is given at 20.2; Havana, 45.7; London, 21,2; Boston, 23.5; St. Petersburg, 51.4. These figures are all from official sources.
