Wenther Bulletin for Eastern Oregon-Fall Wheat Being Sown. Fruit and vegetables Ripening Past.

The mean temperature for the week averaged 71", which was 11" higher than for the preceding week and 16° higher than for the corresponding week of last year. The maximum temperature for the week was 90°, which occured on Friday and Saturday, and the minimum Pullman was 40, which occured on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings. No rain fell Order your fruits, vegetables and fish during the week. Over the Plateau Region, in the more exposed places, frost occured on several mornings.




