It is appreciated. however, that it will be the part of wisdom for the United States to put in the Pacific a force so formidable as to discourage even this suggestion of interference.

Germany's force in the Pacific consists of the armored cruisers Kalser and Deutschland; the protected cruisers Kaisesin Auhusta, Irene, Princess Wilhelm, Geifon, Cormoral and Falke. The displacement of Rear-Admiral Dewey's present force amounts to 30,832




