Blanco Refused to Sustain the Provincial Governor-General in His Debe Removed From the Roof of the Trocha Hotel--Affairs in Matanzas.

MATANZAS, Sept. 22 .- Yesterday morning the American flag was hoisted over the Trocha hotel.

General Arolas, the military governor, went to the palace at noon and protested against the insolence of the action, saying that as military governor he should issue an order forbidding the Stars and Stripes to be hoisted today.

Captain-General Blanco said he would allow no such order to be issued, as the American commissioners were entirely within their rights in having the American flag floated over their residence, and consequency the flag this morning was fact. 
