San Juan, Porto Rico, Sept .- Both the American and Spanish evacuation commissioners have been flooded with appeals for protection. The former were beseeched by the Spanish residents living between the lines and within the American lines to gnard their lives and property from the rapacity of the native inhabitants who were threatening them

with all sorts of prosecutions, and the latter were the subjects of the importunities of the rich Porto Ricans within the Spanish lines, who feared that the Spanish soldiers, as a last act of cruelty, would despoil them of their property and perhaps murder them. 
