Therein lurks a constant danger to the peace compact of the passenger department.

Though of widely diverging character, the freight and passenger departments, in one way, are closely allied, and the troubles of the freight department are liable to creep into the passenger department, then farewell to harmony.

All the freight agents deny that rates are being quoted below tariff prices, but a reporter may see a dezen telegrams a day from agents and shippers showing that concessions are granted to shippers, which means practically the same thing. Every ingenious scheme is resorted to in order to gain business without it being said that rates are quoted below tariff.

A few decisive steps on the part of the interstate commerce commissioners would effectually stop illegal ratecutting and sweep away the danger threatening passenger rates. The agents themselves are anxious to end the tireless underhand struggle, but so long as the other fellow gets business illegally he must protect himself .- Telegram.




