



"Cuba is the key to the Gulf of Mexico and has long been necessary to the United States. For that reason alone she might take upon herself the Cuban debt. When the United States gets Caduce the interest from six to two per negroes. cent."

"You imply that Spain's relinquishment of sovereignty means American annexation, and not the independence of Cuba?"

"Certainly our relinquishment means the transfer of sovereignty over Cuba to America, with all its rights, therefore its obligations."

"Does that apply equally to the Philippines and other debt?"

"No; that case is absolutely opposite America would be extremely unwise to start a policy of colonial expansion. Taking the Philippines would mean a colonial army, a colonial civil service is to be chosen in the last place. But if you can get Dr. Inclination, Dr. Ex-

"But the Americans have fully counted the cost."

"They cannot have done so, because they do not know it. Of course, if the United States were seeking to obtain large interests in the far east, the Philippines would be valuable.
