WILLIE FIELD.

A Tribute to the Memory of One Who Died as Heroes Die.
Poor Willie Field! Few deaths, if any, in recent years have appeared with such eagerness to the people of The Dalles, as has the sudden termination of the bright young life of Willie Field.
When men go to war death must be looked for and is often the inevitable thing, but young Field gave his life, purely and simply, for others. As a nurse of his sick companions in the hospital he inhaled the fatal fever and but a few days had passed till the bright-faced, happy-hearted boy, was tenderly laid at rest far from family and friends. No hero could have died a nobler death. Had Hobson when he went with the Merimac between the blazing guns of the Spaniards met the fate that seemed almost certain to be awaiting him, the country would have mourned the passing

of a heart brave as few ever were. Yet young Field's death is none the less heroic. He did not have the mad exhilaration of battle to sustain him; nor was his courage borne up by the sight of comrades facing the same danger and striving to do the same deeds. But actuated by the spirit of unselfishness, without which no man is really a hero, he took his place in the pestilential hospital and made some poor suffering fellow easier by his sacrifice, and when the roll of bravery is completed high up among the names will be found that of The Dalles boy—Willie Field.

It seems but a few weeks ago that those who attended the foot-ball game at the fair grounds saw him, a leader in the sport, and many who watched him spoke of his manly bearing, little thinking that they were seeing the qualities exhibited them which should grow to greater development and culminate in the self sacrifice at Manila.

It makes little difference where his grave lies. The skies are as blue in the Philippines as they are in Oregon; the spreading palm trees will cast their shadows over him as would the waving pine trees at home. He died as a hero dies and no better nor stronger epitaph could be given him. The flag he fought for and loved salutes him in the morning and bids him "Good Bye" at night and all is well with Willie Field.

"On Fame's eternal camping grounds
Their silent tents are spread
While glory guards with solemn round
The bivouac of the dead."

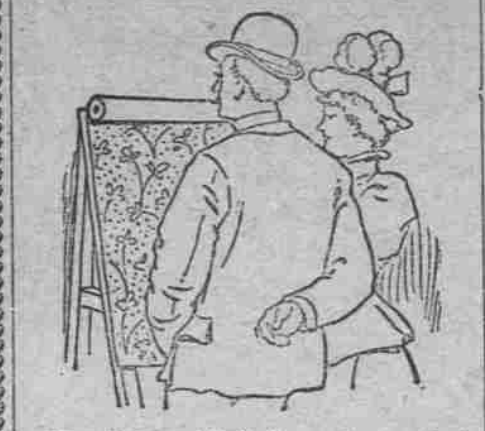
