Sherman county is apparently more interested in The Dalles and Fossil wagon road than are the people of southern Gilliam county, although the latter will undoubtedly receive more benefit from the road than the former. Of course, if we could get an open river to Arlington, there would be very little need for this road, but we very much fear that an open river from Arlington to the sea is a long way off, and will never be realized while Eastern Oregon has a Dalles man in congress. Therefore, let us all work with a will for the wagon road to The Dalles, even in spite of the lack of interest in the project shown by the short-sighted business men of that place.—Fossil Journal.
