DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, General Land Office, Washington, D. C., May 27, 1898. Notice is hereby given of the following Executive Order, restoring certain lands in the Cascade Range Forest Reserve to settlement and entry: "EXECUTIVE MANSION, Washington, D. C., April 29, 1898. In accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 4, 1897 (30 Stat. 36), upon the recommendation of the Secretary of the Interior, the west half of Township 36 South, of Range ten East, Willamette Meridian, Oregon, within the limits of the Cascade Range Forest Reserve, is hereby ordered restored to the public domain, after sixty days notice hereof, by publication, as required by law, it appearing that said tract is better adapted to agricultural than forest purposes. WILLIAM MCKINLEY. The above land will be subject to entry at the United States Land Office, The Dalles, Oregon, on and after October 17, 1898. Binger Hermann, Commissioner.

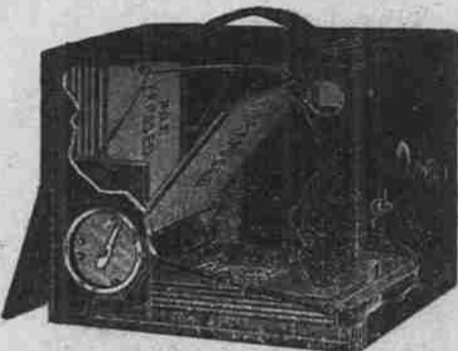
