RAISE THE CRISTOBAL COLON

The Cristobal Colon was one of the finest vessels in the Spanish navy. She was launched in 1896 and was classed in Spain as a battle-ship. She had a displacement of 6,840 tons, engines of 14,000 horse power, a speed of twenty knots, and carried forty guns and four torpedo projectors.

Admiral Sampson in his report stated that the Cristobal Colon was not injured by the firing from his vessels and that she was not much injured by beaching, though she ran ashore at high speed.

Nevertheless, the Cristobal Colon should be raised. There could be no better memorial to the greatest naval engagement of modern times than the rejuvenated Cristobal Colon in the American navy.

Lieutenant Hobson's recommendation was right. The presence of the Cristobal Colon in the American navy would be a constant reminder of American valor and seamanship.
