NEW LIGHT ON THE PHILIPPINES

The adjutant general's office has issued a volume of 300 pages under the title, "Military Notes of the Philippines." Though this volume was prepared principally for the benefit of naval and military officers on duty with the American army of observation and occupation, it contains a large fund of general information.

The Philippine group extends about 1,000 miles north and south, and 600 miles east and west. On the west and northwest is the China sea, on the east is the Pacific, on the south is Borneo, and on the north a number of small islands stretched out toward Formosa.

The Philippine population is estimated at 8,000,000, of which the bulk is of Malay origin. The Philippine Malays, it is stated, are superior to many other Asiatic races, being orderly, courteous, and honest, though exceedingly superstitious.

The soil is reported as most fertile, but agriculture has been almost wholly undeveloped. The islands are very rich in ebony, cedar, ironwood, sapan wood, logwood and gum trees.

The islands are said to be rich in minerals, but little is known by the Spaniards of the ore deposits. Residents do not believe that true coal is to be found in large deposits.

It appears from the government reports that there are numerous harbors in all of the principal Philippine islands which could be easily improved in the interest of commerce.

There is practically no trade in the interior, and the coastwise trade has been managed entirely in the interest of Spain, and yet the islands taken as a whole present fewer difficulties in the way of road building and railroad building than did Arizona.

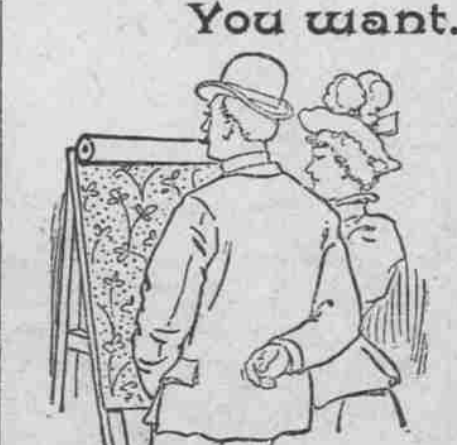

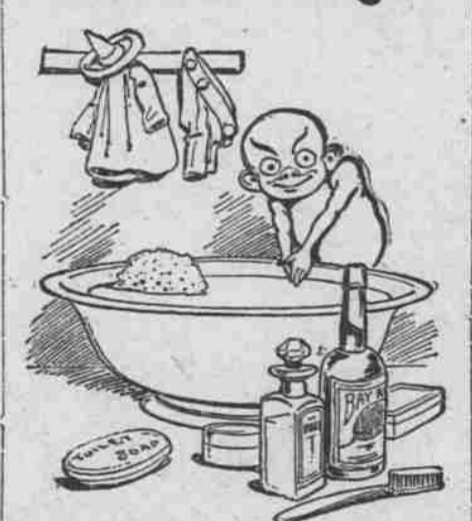
