Camara Today.

SPANIARDS APE READY AT LAST

Reply to the American Ultimatum of Three Weeks Ago to be Presented -American Commissioners Confident that Definite Results Will Be Reached at This Meeting.

New York, Nov. 15 .- A special to the Herald from Havana says:

GeneralParrado has informed General Butler that the Spanish commission is ready to give its answer to the American ultimatum presented at the joint session nearly three weeks ago. The result will be a joint session at Camara Insular on Wednesday morning at 9 o'clock. The Americans confidentially hope that a full agreement on the date of evacuation will be reached.

Dr. O'Reilly, who has been ordered to report in Washington, will leave for the North by Wednesday's boat to Tampa. Dr.O'Reilly will urge upon the administration the immediate necessity of establishing an American hospital and the organization of a sanitary brigade for cleaning the city. Careful estimates have been made, showing that the surface of the city in the streets and yards may be cleaned and disinfected at a cost of not exceeding \$20,000. When it is considered that the expenditure of this sum would mean the saving of American lives, it seems more than criminal that it has not already been done.


