Spanish Commissioners Declare They Yield to Superior Force.

## YIELD TO AVOID <br> HORRORS OF WAR

Cession of the Entire Pbilippine Archi pelago and the Sulu Islands and the Sale of the Carolines is Agreed To-Conclusion of a Peace Treaty Now Near at Hand-European Powers Not Pleased.

P^rus, Nov. 28.-Spain has acceded to the demands of the United States, and agreed to cede the entire Philippine archipelago and the Sulu inlands, and to
sell the Caroline ielsande. This practice sill insares the conclusion of a preatyopence bere the conclusion of a treaty of Statee in the near future.
Pasis, Nov, 28.-The two peace commieaions were in separate session all met at $20^{\prime}$ clock this afternoon, and the Spanish commissionere immediately announced their acceptance of the American demands. The Spanish sccoptance
