CHRISTMAS IN NEW AMERICA

Christmas of 1898 finds the United States in a mood which is in especial harmony with the associations connected with the day. 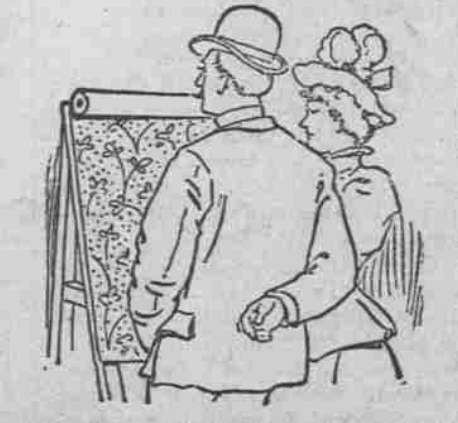

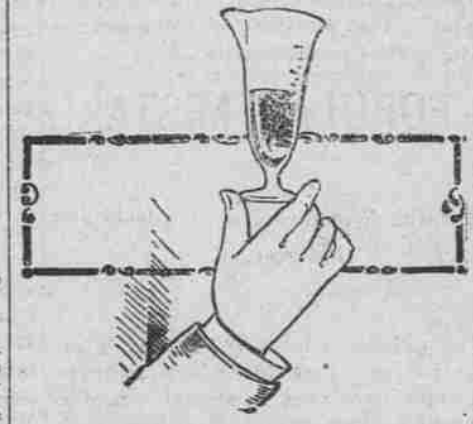
