A LOOK AHEAD.

A little less than a year and a half ago Capt. A. T. Mahan published in one of the magazines an article on the probable tendencies of international civilization in the twentieth century...

The test seemed a long way off at that moment. But in less than ten months the Philippines were held by our fleet. Without mentioning them by name, Capt. Mahan spoke regretfully of the fact that the Spanish colonies in the West Indies were in hands "which not only never have given, but to all appearance never can give, the development which is required by the general interest."

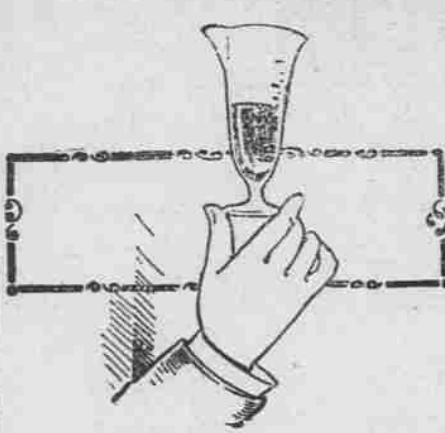

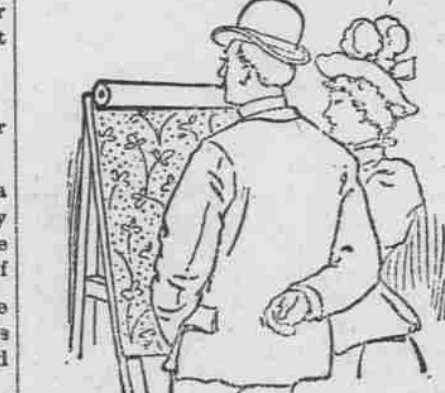
