ALBANY, Or. Jan. 14 .- A special to the Herald from Mill City says: J. C. Lyons, a merchant, was murdered in a room back of his store about 9 o'cleck last night, having been shot by an unknown assassian through a window from the outside. The weapon used was a shotgun, loaded with mixed shot, and the charge entered the back of Lyons' neck, some passing through, and com ing out under the chin.

The victim lived about an hour after being shot, and was conscious to the last. It is not known that he made any statement that would give any clue to the murderer.


