Te Protec: Domestic Animals.

The bill of Representative Grace, of Baker county, to prohibit the poisoning of domestic animals, is receiving the favorable opinion of nearly every member of the legislature, and will unquestionably become a law. The full text of the bill is as follows:

"If any person shall put out or place any poison where the same is liable to be eaten by any horse, cattle, sheep, hog, or other domestic animals of value, the property of another, with intent to poison such animal, such person, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment in the penitentiary not

Pioneer Orchestra Leader Dies. SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 18 .- The death is announced of Joseph L. Schmitz, the leader of the first theater orchestra in this city. He came here from New York in 1850. 




