Superintendent Chase, of the Linnton Smelter, looks for the works to start up again soon, as the stockholders, he thinks, can see daylight through the litigation connected with the plant.

The location of the Linnton smelter is all that can be desired, in Mr. Chase's opinion, as the works are equally accessible to the ores of Eastern Oregon, Washington, Idaho and Montana, as well as those of Southern Oregon and Northern California. 
