4:44 p. m .- The enemy's sharpshooters have been particularly active about Calocan all day. Special attention was paid to a three-gun battery near the railroad, and the improvement of the rebel marksmanship was very noticeable. The rebels fired volleys at the battery, bullets frequently skimming the tops of the sandbags.

A lieutenant of the Twentieth Kansas volunteers, and three other men were alightly wounded. A man was killed in the trenches today.

The rebel battery has not been used since the shell from the Monadnock was exploded over it yesterday.

The enemy's fire was so hot during the night in the vicinity of Higgins' house that the headquarters were removed to a church 400 yards inside of the line.

A few small fires have destroyed several native houses in the outskirts of the city.

The Twentieth infantry is being disembarked from the transport Scandia.
